Choir program at Church of the Atonement: Restructured the existing two choir program at the Church of the Atonement in collaboration with the Choirmaster and Organist, into a program with three ensembles: the Atonement Schola (10 professional voices), the Atonement Choir (15-20 professional and volunteer singers), and the St. Cecilia Choir (un-auditioned parish choir). This has bolstered congregational participation while increasing the quality and diversity of weekly repertoire, including a weeknight Evensong service.
